BIOGRAPHY

Jerry White is currently Full Professor in the Department of Sociology. He stepped down as Senior Associate Dean Faculty of Social Science in 2015. He is director of the Aboriginal Policy Research Consortium (International); Editor-in-Chief of the *International Indigenous Policy Journal* and a senior associate editor of *Regions: Economics and Sociology, Russian Academy of Sciences*. As a Professor and former Chair of the Department of Sociology, he has held many posts at the University of Western Ontario including Acting Director of First Nation Studies, and Senior Advisor to the Vice President. Jerry served 8 years on Western's Board of Governors, King's University Board of Directors and as President for Board of the Museum of Ontario Archeology until June 2014. Over his career, he has served on many public inquiries and Provincial boards including being the founding co-Chair of the Ontario Health Professions Regulatory Advisory Council. In this capacity, he implemented the Regulated Health Professions Act.

Dr. White has won numerous teaching awards, including the Pleva Teaching Excellence Award from Western's Senate and has authored, co-authored and/or edited over 20 books including *Aboriginal Conditions: Research as a Foundation for Policy* (UBCPress 2003), *Aboriginal Well-being: Canada's Continuing Challenge* (TEP 2007), *Aboriginal Education: Current Crisis, Future Alternatives* (TEP 2009) and the 10 book series *Aboriginal Policy Research: Moving Forward making a Difference*.
