### *Undergraduate*

During the last ten years of my career, my primary teaching responsibility was Introductory Statistics and Research Methods. This course provided students with the basic tools of statistical research, from simple descriptive statistics to simple regression. It also covered a wide variety of topics in Research Methods, including questionnaire design, survey research, secondary data analysis and qualitative research. I also taught the second level of Research Methods, as well as a Senior Research Seminar in which students essentially completed a bachelor's thesis. Both quantitative and qualitative projects were executed by the students.

My substantive teaching included Sociology of Health and Illness at the general and honours Undergraduate levels.

### *Graduate*

I have taught several courses in health-related topics at the graduate level. However, my greatest contribution to graduate students has been as mentor and supervisor, both in the Department of Sociology and in several other departments at Western.

## **IV Awards and Honours**

I was recognized by the Panhellenic Council for Excellence in Teaching several times during my teaching career. As well, I was also placed on the University Students' Council's Honour Roll for Teaching for a number of years during the time I taught the statistics and research methods courses.
