JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Institute of Public and International Affairs (IPIA) at the University of Utah is seeking to fill a post-doctoral position in Demography of Aging. IPIA is housed within the College of Social and Behavioral Science and has the general goal of facilitating and enhancing the University's interdisciplinary activities and programs. Within the general area of Demography of Aging, a successful candidate will have research interests that intersect with one or more of the following broadly viewed subjects: biodemography, migration, developing and/or emerging societies, health/disability/mortality, population aging. The successful candidate will be expected to work with researchers affiliated with IPIA on Demography of Aging projects and within an interdisciplinary environment. The individual must have a Ph.D. prior to starting the position and it should be in a discipline represented in the College of Social and Behavioral Science ([CSBS](#)) at the University of Utah.

The position could begin as early as August, 2009; however the starting date is negotiable. It will run for twelve months with the possibility of a 12 month renewal upon adequate progress.

In the application, please include a CV, a short (maximum two page) research statement, and names and contact information of three potential referees. Additional information may be requested at a later time.
